LOGISTIC NOTE

Venue Information

- 11 October (All day): Sala della Protomoteca, Campidoglio Piazza Venezia
- 12 October (Morning): Sala della Protomoteca, Campidoglio Piazza Venezia
- 12 October (Afternoon): Casa Internazionale delle Donne Via della Lungara 19
- 13 October (Morning): Casa Internazionale delle Donne Via della Lungara 19

Sala della Protomoteca, Campidoglio.

Once you reached the square of the Campidoglio at the end of the stairs you will see a statue with a man on a horse (Marco Aurelio). Please keep the right side as you have the statue in front of you. At the end of the arcades on your right side you will see some white stairs. Climb them and at the end of it, on the left side you will find the entrance to the Sala della Protomoteca.

Interpretation

- 11 October (all day): there will be simultaneous interpretation (English-Italian) during the first day. You will need to leave a document/ID to get a headset.
- 12 October (morning): there will be simultaneous interpretation (English-Arabic-Italian). You will need to leave a document/ID to get a headset.
- 12 October (afternoon): no interpretation. Working language English.
- 13 October (morning): no interpretation. Working language English.

How to reach the City Center (Termini Train Station) from the Airports

From FIUMICINO Airport:


- Option 1: Go to the train station of the Fiumicino Airport and take the train Leonardo Express to Termini Train Station. The train travels everyday of the week every 30 minutes and connects the Airport of Fiumicino to Termini Train Station from 6:36 to 23.36 and in the opposite way from Termini Train Station to Fiumicino Airport from 5.52 to 22:52. The train is direct and it takes 31 minutes. You will be able to buy the train ticket at the ticket office in the airport, it costs 14,00 euro. Please remind to punch the ticket in the orange boxes that you will find in the train station, once you get in the train you are not allowed to punch it anymore.
- Option 2: Go to the train station of the Fiumicino Airport and take the train FM1 (direction Fara Sabina) and get off at OSTIENSE train station. The train travels from Monday to Friday everyday 15 minutes (Saturday and Sunday only every 30 minutes) and connects the Airport of Fiumicino to Ostiense train Station from 5:57 to 23:27 and in the opposite way from Ostiense Station to Fiumicino Airport from 5:18 to 22:48. You will be able to buy the train ticket at the ticket office in the airport, it costs 8,00 euro. Please remind to punch the ticket in the orange boxes that you will find in the train station, once you get in the train you are not allowed to punch it anymore. Once in OSTIENSE Train Station, take the subway at PIRAMIDE LINE B direction Rebibbia and get down at Termini Train Station.
- Option 3: take a taxi. The run to the city center has fix price of 40 euro. The taxis are white cars.

From CIAMPINO Airport:

Take a bus to Termini (price 4 euro, for timetable please have a look at http://www.terravision.eu/rome ciampino.html.)

How to reach The Town Hall (Campidoglio) from...and to

- From Termini Train station to the Campidoglio: take bus number 170 (Agricoltura) for 7 stops. It runs more or less every 8 minutes. Get down from the bus at the stop TEATRO MARCELLO/ARA COELI. Cross the street and you will have in front the stairs of the Campidoglio. Our volunteers will be there to guide you on the morning of the 11th and 12th until nine o'clock.
- From the Campidoglio to Termini Train Station: Cross the streets and go the bus stop TEATRO MARCELLO/ARA COELI. Get the line 170 (directionTermini) for 7 stops. It runs more or less every 8 minutes.
- From La Casa Internazionale delle Donne to the Campidoglio: If you want to walk have a look at the map below. It is a 15 minutes nice walk through the city center. If you wish to take a bus please go to the bus stop Farnesina (From the entrance of Via della Lungara take the climb in front of you and then turn to the right. Walk some meters and you will find the yellow bus stop. There pick up the line 271 (direction san paolo) for four stops. It runs every 20 minutes. Get down at the stop TEATRO MARCELLO/ARA COELI. Cross the street and you will have in front the stairs of the Campidoglio. Our volunteers will be there to guide you on the morning of the 11th and 12th until nine o'clock.
- From Campidoglio to la Casa Internazionale delle Donne: on the 12th at lunch a group of volunteers will guide you. For the other day you can have a walk taking a look at map below. It is a 15 minutes nice walking. By bus cross the street and go to the bus stop TEATRO MARCELLO/ARA COELI. Pick up line 271 (direction S. Giuliano) for three stops and get down at the bus stop VALLATI/PETTINARI. From there cross the bridge of Ponte Sisto and turn to right. Cross the street and keep walking to the right. After some meters you will find a descent on your left side. Go down and you are in Via della Lungara 19.

- Please note that Rome has only two lines of subways (due to all the ancient roman ruins underground!) and none of them arrives to Piazza Venezia.

 - Anyway the best subway stop to get down is Termini Train Station (both line A and B arrive there), Piazza di Spagna (Line A) and Colosseo (line B).
- From the stop Colosseo you can take a walk until the conference venue of the townhall walking. Get out from the metro station turn to your right and walk trough via dei Fori Imperiali. Then you will arrive to Piazza Venezia. Just go around the big white monument in the middle of the city and turn left. There you will see to stairs. The first one lead you to a church the second one will lead you to the square of the Campidoglio Town Hall. If you don't want to walk you can:

Useful information

- For security reasons of the Townhall no luggage beside hand-luggage will be let in the Campidoglio. Please leave them at the hotel.
- A team of nine volunteers will be helping you during all the conference. The volunteers coordinator is Cristina Karadole. All of them speak English and other languages as well.
- Climate: it is foreseen sun during the entire week. Min. 10° and Max. 25°.
- In the patio of La Casa Internazionale delle Donne there will be free wifi. No wi-fi connection is foreseen at the Town Hall.
